#### **2. The Sports Club (Leader: Tanveer Ahmad):**

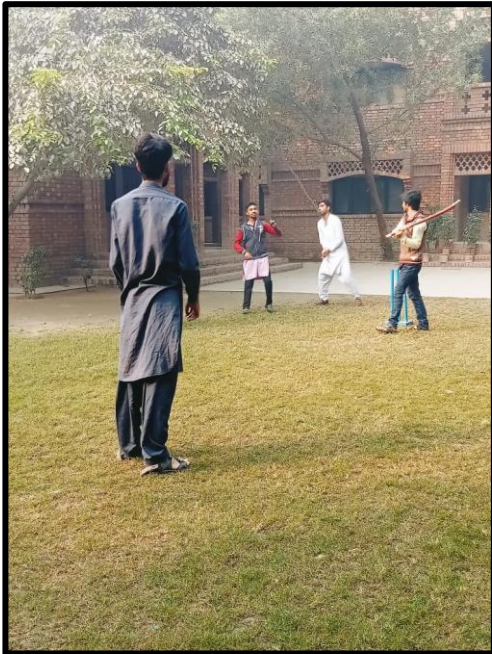
- They held cricket and football matches amongst the participants.
